Summer Class



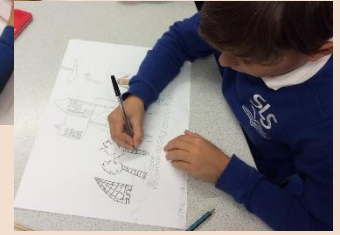

Autumn Class



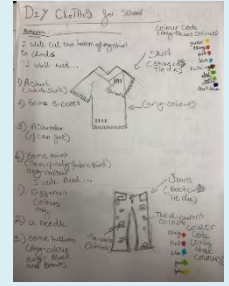
