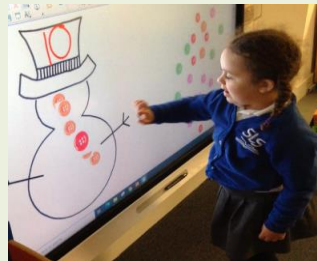

In Mathematics we have been finding the next multiple of 10, practising our number bonds and partitioning numbers into tens and ones. In Science we have been looking at animals and ways that they can be categorised by looking at their different features.



Autumn Class

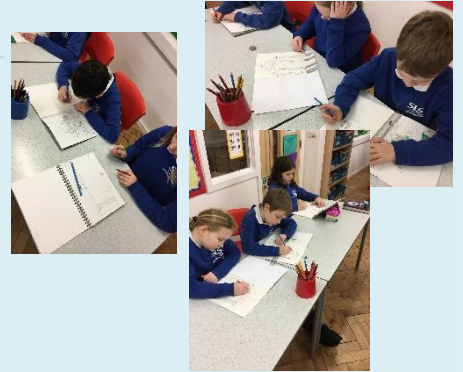

The most common symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19) are recent onset of any of the following:

a new continuous cough

a high temperature

a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

For most people, coronavirus (COVID-19) will be a mild illness. However, if you have any of the symptoms above you should self-isolate at home and get tested
