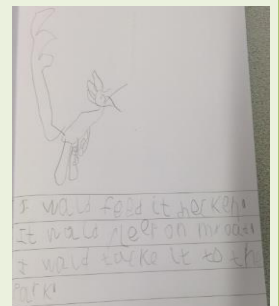

Summer Class



This week in English we have been writing about the Great Fire of London using the five senses. We pretended that we had lived at the time of the Great Fire and wrote journal entries describing what we experienced. In Mathematics, we have been revising different strategies to help us add and subtract, and we also revised fractions of shapes and numbers. In Topic we learned about fire safety, created fire safety posters and compared fire services in the past to those we have today.

In Maths, we have been learning about written methods for division and in English we have been writing poems about sounds we might hear at night.
