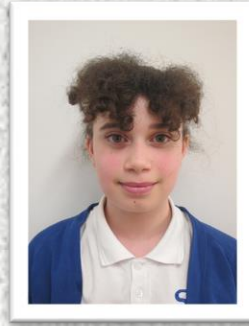

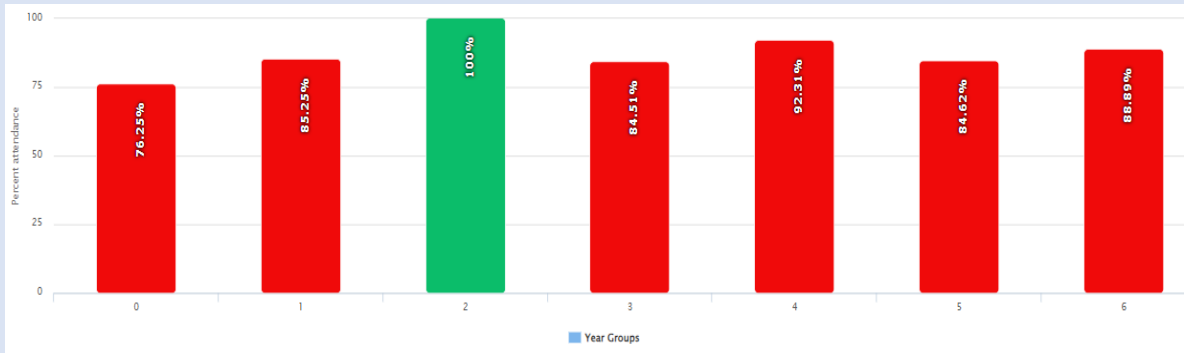


Year 6 Leavers

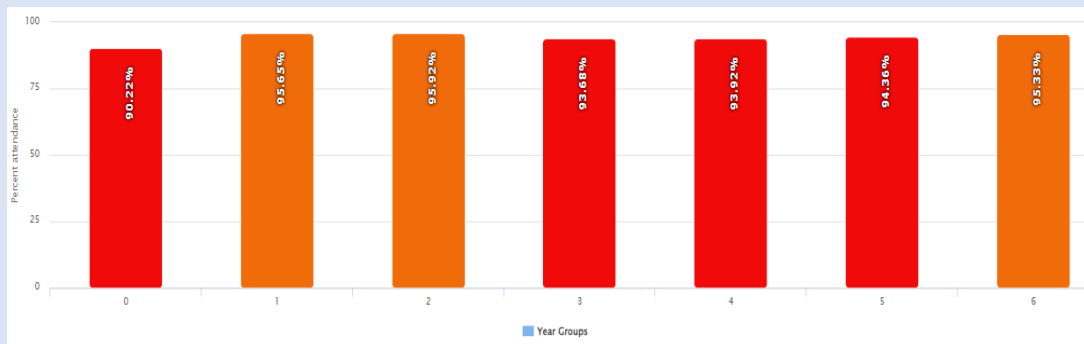
Weekly Attendance
